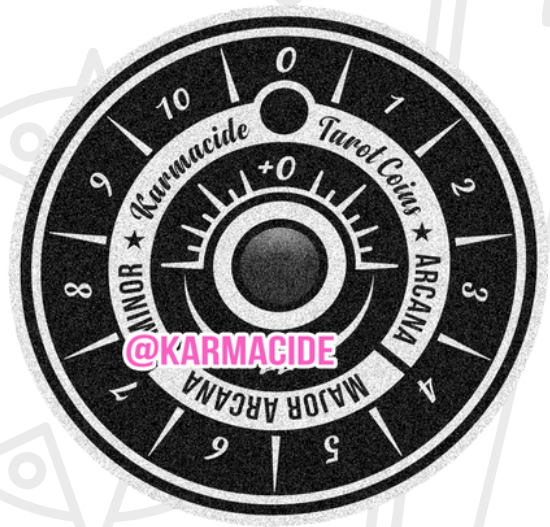
Instructions

Using your Tarot Coin as a fully functional deck is extremely easy, with no shuffling required!

Getting to Know Your Coin

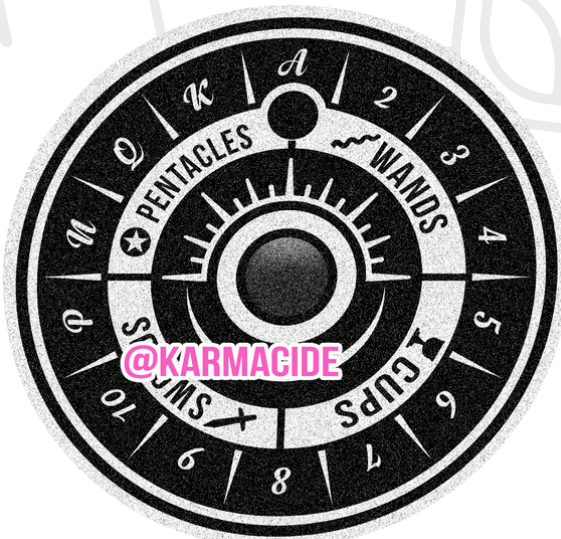
Front (Major/Heads)

The front of your coin will have the words Minor and Major Arcana engraved in it. It will start with the number 0, and end on 10



Back (Minor/Tails)

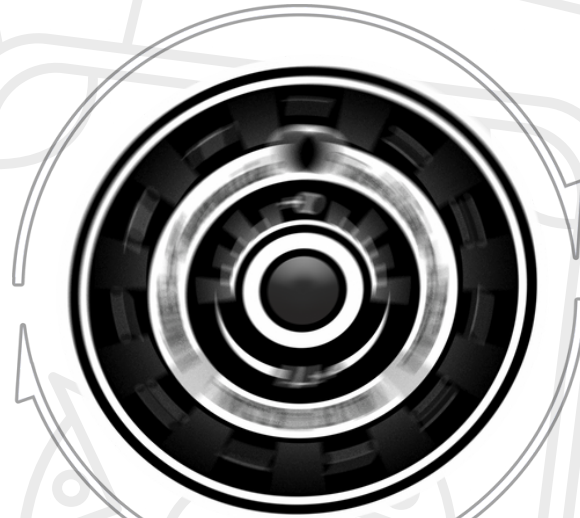
The back of your coin will have the words "Pentacles", "Wands", "Cups", and "Swords" engraved on it. It will start with the letter "A" and end on "K"



Instructions (P2)

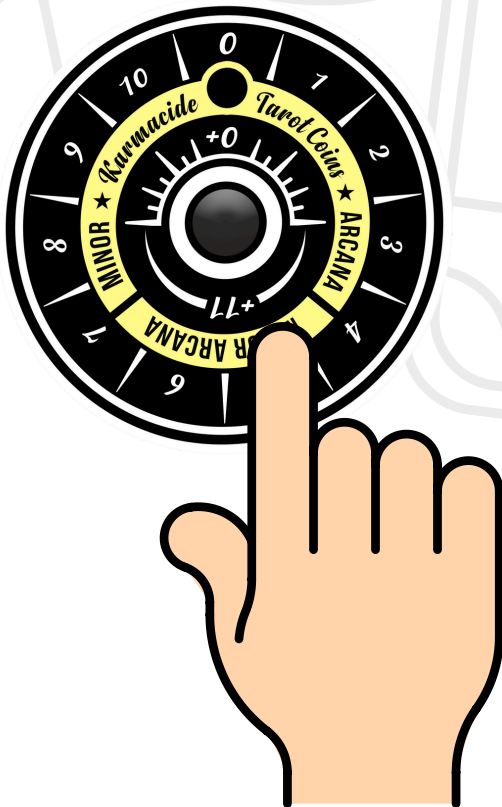
Step 1

Starting with the "Heads" side of your coin, grab the coin, and give it a spin.



Step 2

Stop the spinning of the coin with your finger, and notice where your finger lands, focusing on if you land on either the "Major" or "Minor" Arcana section.

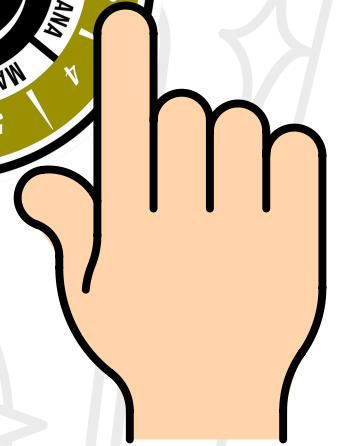
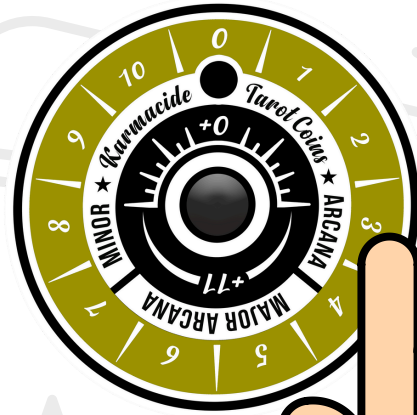


Instructions (p3)

Step 3

(Major Arcana)

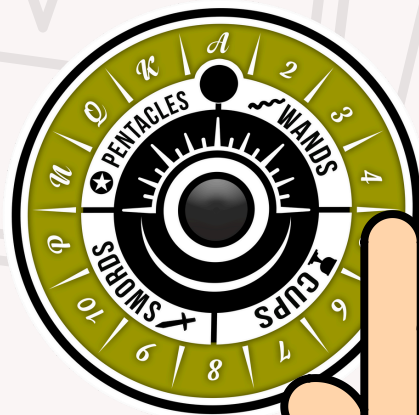
*If your finger landed on "Major", stay on the Major side, spin and stop the coin again with your finger, while focusing on where your finger lands (outer numerals numbered 0-10). Remember this number.



(Minor Arcana)

*If your finger landed on "Minor", *flip the coin over and spin again.

Stop the spin with your finger, while focusing on where your finger lands (outer numerals numbered A-K)



Instructions (p4)

Step 4

(Major Arcana)

While staying on the "Major" side, concentrate on the inner part of the coin, and spin again, and stop it with your finger one final time, while noticing whether you land on +0 or +11.

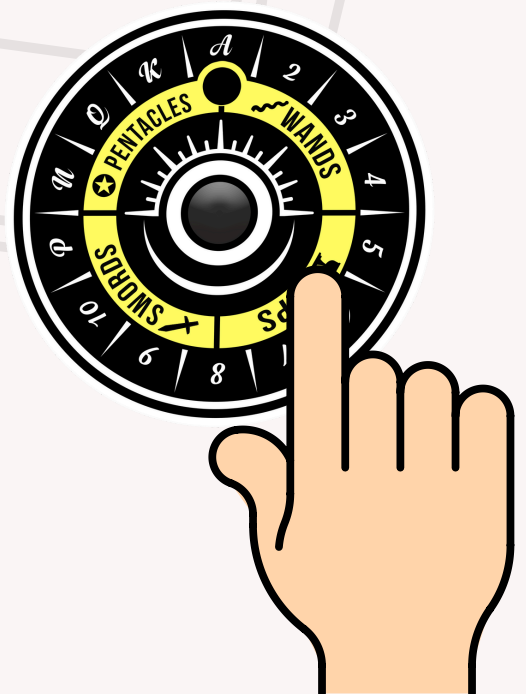
For your final results, take either the +0 or +11 and add it to the number you landed on in step 3. You can refer to the cheat sheet below for your card.



(Minor Arcana)

While staying on the Minor side, spin and stop with your finger one final time, noticing if you land on either "Wands", "Cups", "Swords", or "Pentacles".

For your final results, combine the suite with the number drew during Step 3.



Instructions (p5)

That's it! You've now drawn your card. Please refer to our cheat sheet (p 9) to match the number with the card, as it'll take some repetition to memorize.

*Note- In the event that you draw 2 identical cards, you can either:

1. draw/spin your last number again (preferred), *or
2. move 1 up to the next card on the same side. (for example: if you draw the Fool on the Major Arcana two times in a row, the second draw would become the Magician)

*Also- You can use the center of either sides to determine heads or tails, as some tarot practitioners use the direction of the cards in their readings, as the sun represents "Heads", and the moon represents "Tails".
